President's Report for Glen Waverley Inter Church Council AGM

Wednesday 3 November. 2021.

During December I drove up Springvale Road frequently and had a quick glance at our Christmas board in Central Reserve, when I was stopped at the lights. I felt that the board was an excellent witness to the local community as I'm sure it will be this year. Thanks to everyone who helped to put the board up and arranged for its storage for another year.

In February a number of church representatives met to plan Ecumenical Visitors Sunday in May. Unfortunately the visits were unable to take place because of lockdowns. Prayers were circulated to churches to use internally but it wasn't the same as having the prayers read and candles lit by visitors from other churches. We hope that this annual tradition can go ahead next year.

In March, Alison Clarkson and I organised and led the World Day of Prayer service at Glen Waverley Uniting Church. We were worried about the possibility of lockdowns and decided to live stream the service. Quite a few people tuned in to watch the service. The country that was featured was Vanuatu and we were lucky enough to have Mark Zirnsak from the Synod of Victoria and Tasmania as our guest speaker. Next year's focus is the United Kingdom.

I also attended the Harmony Dinner at Mulgrave Community Centre in March. This was different as we were starting to observe social distancing and other COVID RITUALS and each participant received their own packed meal instead of having a smorgasbord and people helping themselves. It was good to meet up with people from different churches and faith communities and hear the speakers including the Mayor of Monash.

Good Friday was on 2 April. Reluctantly we had to cancel the Way of the Cross at Central Reserve as restrictions made it too difficult. We are looking forward to going ahead with this special event in 2022.

We have continued to meet on Zoom and see each other. We thank Glen Waverley Uniting church for letting us use their Zoom account.

It is always difficult when you start naming and thanking people for their work on a committee but I'm going to do it anyway. I want to thank you all for serving faithfully on this committee. When help or support is needed you are there. We have all helped when there have been information to be delivered to motels, hotels and aged care facilities. Thanks Francisco for being our secretary, Joe for keeping us informed about Monash Interfaith Gatherings, Tony for keeping us informed about the Victorian Council of Churches information and newsletters and John for keeping his eye on the website and doing updates when necessary.

I think that I need to make a more concerted effort to interest people in joining our committee-maybe some extra coffees double strength!!!!! I haven't managed to visit churches and ministerial teams as I planned to. Hopefully our circumstances will be less chaotic early next year and I can make these visits a first priority.
