
Racism and discrimination have no place in our society. Every Victorian has the right to feel safe and secure in the community.

Churches to celebrate

CHRISTIANITY is a religion known for its diversity – Catholics, Baptists, Anglicans and others each have their own way of worshipping. But Twenty-one churches in Monash will get together to celebrate the 2000th birthday of Christianity.

The churches will each have an ecumenical celebration on June 11, which is Pentecost Sunday, traditionally marked as the birth of Christianity.

As part of the event, 12 members of each congregation will attend services at other churches.

The Rev. Robert Elkhuizen, of the Glen Waverley Uniting Church, said the day was seen as a way to unify the faiths.

“Despite our diversity we still have a common faith,” he said.

Mr Elkhuizen said although Christian churches were mindful of their failings in the past, there was still much to celebrate.

“The Christian faith is still significant, Christians contribute a lot to society.”

Mr Elkhuizen, who is president of the Glen Waverley Interchurch Council, said the services would be an opportunity for the wider community, including those who were not regular churchgoers, to take part.

Fr Michael Wheeler, of St Justin’s Catholic Church in Wheelers Hill, said visitors from other congregations would be welcome at the service.

Fr Wheeler said the services were a “wonderful gesture” that showed how much Christianity had changed since the days when people were banned from going inside churches of other denominations.

“It’s a sign of co-operation and unity . . . it tries to break down the barriers and the mysteries,” he said.
